Specific examples include: Where Do We Grow From Here? the region-wide visioning process focused on land use and transportation in Greater Cincinnati for the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments; Together Aiken County, a vision and strategic plan for Aiken County, South Carolina; Regional Connections, the seven-county regional growth strategy and conceptual development framework for central Ohio; Franklin Tomorrow, a vision for the future of growth and development for Franklin, Tennessee; Community COMPASS, a vision for a comprehensive plan for Hamilton County/Cincinnati, Ohio; Create the Vision, a comprehensive plan for the City of Centerville and Washington Township; Involve Ogden, a vision and general plan for Ogden, Utah; and a vision, comprehensive plan and five study area plans for Upper Arlington, Ohio.

Mr. Greene has presented the work of ACP at many national, regional and local conferences, including: American Planning Association (APA), Society of College and University Planners, Managing Change Coalition, and Common Destiny. He has served as an adjunct faculty member of the Knowlton School of Architecture at The Ohio State University from 1999-2001 and 2003-2005. Among other professional and civic activities, Mr. Greene is a Planning Commissioner for the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio and member of the RegionLink Advisory Group of the Alliance for Regional Stewardship.

He holds a Masters of Urban and Environmental Planning from the University of Virginia and a Bachelor of Science in Architecture, cum laude, from The Ohio State University.
